## 2012 Annual Program Report

### Planning for the Future — a word from the President

*The Sauk County Institute of Leadership (SCIL)* is now in its 15th year of **developing informed, civic-minded leaders who are committed to a vibrant Sauk County.** On behalf of the entire SCIL Board of Directors, I would like to congratulate each graduating student from the class of 2012. SCIL graduates have demonstrated a desire to better their community. The nine session course completed by these students is intended to further enhance their skill-set and serve as a tool for engaged, active, and involved community leaders.

The Sauk County Institute of Leadership can take pride in its primary accomplishment since its inception — program completion of 239 students. In today's ever changing environment, successful organizations continually evaluate their mission and vision and put themselves in a position to excel in future years. Part of this process is the adaption of a strategic plan. The SCIL Board of Directors has spent much of their committee time over the past year evaluating, reviewing and putting a strategic plan in place.

The SCIL mission statement accurately reflects the purpose of SCIL and remains unchanged. A vision statement and strategic plan are being revised by the Board of Directors. The process started with a group session where nearly 150 questions were posed, then categorized. This led to four standing committees: 1) Finance, Structure and

Scholarship; 2) Learning Objectives and Program Evaluation; 3) Alumni and Continuing Education; 4) Recruitment and Marketing. Each committee is going through the process of evaluating the questions and developing their segment of the strategic plan. This committee reorganization, coupled with the adaption and future implementation of a strategic plan, puts SCIL in a position to carry out its mission over the next several years.

The Sauk County Institute of Leadership would like to welcome our new Program Advisor, Lisa Wenzel. Lisa is a recent SCIL graduate with a wide array of community development experience. Lisa will be replacing Jenny Erickson on many of the "day to day" responsibilities. However, Jenny continues to serve in an advisory role.

Finally, SCIL would like to thank its leadership award winner, Sauk Prairie Memorial Hospital (SPMH). SPMH has sponsored 17 SCIL students, participated on the SCIL Board, volunteered usage of their facility for classroom activities, and volunteered their expert speakers for relevant classroom presentations.

As I look back on the achievements of the SCIL program, not only last year but the past 15 years, I hope you will join me in celebrating the many accomplishments. With the help of the SCIL Board, alumni, and business and community partners, Sauk County has the leadership potential for a bright future.

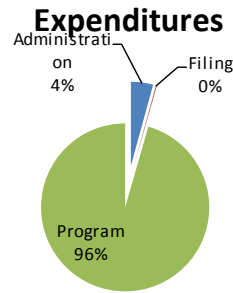
