The *Sauk County Institute of Leadership (SCIL)* is a program dedicated to developing informed, civic-minded leaders who are committed to a vibrant Sauk County and its local communities.

SCIL has graduated 277 engaged, active, and involved community leaders since its inception in 1997. The intensive nine-month course is intended to develop and further enhance individual and group skillsets. Participants are selected through a competitive application process, and the program is funded entirely from student fees. Program graduates represent a true cross-section of Sauk County residents — from high-school students to working professionals to retired citizens continuing their life-long education. SCIL members demonstrate a desire to better their community through active participation in sessions on a variety of relevant topics, including: politics, economic development, education, arts, agriculture, conservation, and healthcare; combined with leadership skill building at each session. Participants are also required to complete a community service activity.

The SCIL Board continues to move forward with the strategic plan implemented under the leadership of Past President Jason Begalske, and would like to thank Lisa Wenzel, UW Extension — Sauk County Community Resource Development/SCIL Program Advisor, and Jenny Erickson, UW Extension — Sauk County Resource Development

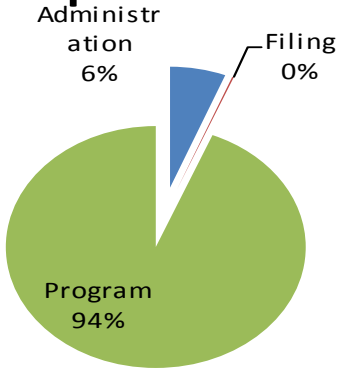
