The *Sauk County Institute of Leadership (SCIL)* is a program dedicated to developing informed, civic-minded leaders who are committed to a vibrant Sauk County and its local communities.

SCIL has graduated 277 engaged, active, and involved community leaders since its inception in 1997. The intensive nine-month course is intended to develop and further enhance individual and group skillsets. Participants are selected through a competitive application process, and the program is funded entirely from student fees. Program graduates represent a true crosssection of Sauk County residents — from highschool students to working professionals to retired citizens continuing their life-long education. SCIL members demonstrate a desire to better their community through active participation in sessions on a variety of relevant topics, including: politics, economic development, education, arts, agriculture, conservation, and healthcare; combined with leadership skill building at each session. Participants are also required to complete a community service activity.
